Mission Uganda 2013

The Harambee International Development (HID) in partnership Shiloh Baptist Church of Alexandria, Virginia has continued to actively spread God's Word across the globe. In December 2013, HID and Shiloh International Missions Team went to Uganda. The Life Renewal Ministry Church is a daughter church of Shiloh Baptist Church and is founded out of Shiloh's efforts in Soroti, Uganda.

HID lead a team of Shiloh and other church members to spread God's work in Uganda. The team visited a local hospital and provided medical supplies, visited schools and provided school supplies and met with members of the Soroti Pastor's and Elders Fellowship. Pastor Joseph Eletu, Senior Pastor of Life Renewal Ministry and his wife Susan hosted a reception at his lovely home for the team. We had a three-night revival near the church and hundreds accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Reverend Dangerfield preached the revival and Sunday service at Life Renewal Ministry. As part of Sunday's service, we baptized over two hundred new converts in the Nile River. This was a truly rewarding experience and the highlight of our trip. Mission Brazil 2014

In November 2014, HID, Shiloh's International Missions Team in partnership with Shalom Outreach, Inc. went to Sao Paulo, Brazil for an urban mission trip. HID led a team of Shiloh members and other church ministers to the needs of our brothers and sisters in Brazil. The Team distributed food and ministered to the homeless in a city square. Members of the team distributed clothes to those in need at a low income housing complex. The team went on a day trip to a mountaintop to provide ministry support and encouragement to members of an addiction rehabilitation center. This experience broke yolks, changed lives and had everyone crying and praising God. Each night Reverend Dangerfield preached in revivals around the city and large numbers accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. The team visited recreation centers to encourage children with clothes, toys, gifts and words of encouragement and support. Team members taught and ministered during a two-day conference with the theme Focus on the Family. The team also went to Rio de Janerio to visit religious sites and see Brazilian culture. Mission South Africa 2016

In October and November 2016, HID, the Shiloh International Missions Team in partnership with Know The Truth Ministries showed the love of Christ in the South African cities of Johannesburg and Cape Town. HID lead a team of Shiloh and other church members to minister chairs to Zamintuthuko Primary School to improve education environment of hundreds of children in this poor school. Additionally, Shiloh funds were used to purchase musical instruments and fencing for a garden for Bushabezwe Aids and Charity House an after school program operating out of their physical needs and take home to parents for food security. The Team adopted the Jehovah Jira Orphanage Mama Nelly Matjaka and her family provided care for 30 children who had lost their parents. Food, clothes, shoes and other necessities were purchased to aid the needs of kids. The Team provide compassion and encouragement to each child showing God's love encouraging them to have faith in God and strive to set high goals and work hard to accomplish them. The Teams work in schools and orphanage and other low income areas, provided aid and assistance as instruments of God from the members of Shiloh Baptist Church and partnering church's. The Team developed a partnership with Life Centre Bible Church in a suburb of Johannesburg. Dr. Soji Shogun is Pastor. The Team also went the Soweto Ghetto to expand the Word of God and show the love of Christ. The Team spent time in Cape Town, street witnessing as they saw the beautiful sights of are.
