



SOUTH AFRICA 2024 JOURNEY OVERVIEW

Harambee International Development would like to thank you for your expression of interest in our October 13-25, 2024 journey to South Africa. Please examine our flyer for a general review of trip information and \$5,500 cost, which includes international and local airfares, transportation, tours, meals and soft drinks. In South Africa, we will spend three days in Cape Town, three days in Durban and visit Johannesburg for four days. The journey will explore South African cultural, history, food and geographic sites. There will be at least two tours in each of the major city areas. A safari overnight can be arranged while in Johannesburg for an additional fee.

To participate in this trip, you will need a current United States passport, that will not expire within six-months after date of trip. Please confer with your medical doctor and the Center for Disease Control to determine immunization requirements.

We are close to 19 months before the start of this trip and we will accept payments beginning immediately. You can pay off trip cost of \$5,500 at any time. However, you must at a minimum, meet the following payment schedule:

- First payment of \$1,000 due by June 1, 2023 (\$500 is non-refundable administrative costs);
- Second payment of \$1,000 due by August 1, 2023;
- Third payment of \$1,000 is due by December 1, 2023;
- Fourth payment of \$1,000 is due by February 1, 2024; and
- Final payment of \$1500 is due by May 1, 2024.
