



SENEGAL 2025 CULTURAL AWARENESS JOURNEY OVERVIEW

PRICING AND PAYMENTS

The total price for individuals going to Senegal is \$5,500 (subject to changes due to covid or economic situations). This price includes airfare from Washington, DC, lodging, breakfast meals transportation and tours. Single rooms will require an additional payment of \$1,000+.

Payments can be made at any time beginning September 1, 2024, and final payment is due by May 1, 2025.

An initial payment of \$1,000 (which includes a non-refundable \$500 administrative processing fee) must be received by October 1, 2024.

1. A second payment of \$1,500 must be made by December 1, 2024.
2. A third payment of \$1,500 must be made by March 1, 2025.
3. The final payment of \$2,000 must be made by May 15, 2025.
