ETHIOPIA 2026 CULTURAL AWARENESS JOURNEY

Harambee International Development (HID) has created a journey to Ethiopia to explore the history, people, culture, food and scenic beauty of this great land.

The \$5,800+ costs (Subject to changing economic conditions) to go on Ethiopia October 2026 Journey includes airfare, hotels, meals and tours of four major areas in Ethiopia.

The tour will be flights within Ethiopia, by air condition motor coach, with expert guides and the best hotels in each area visited. The Journey is limited to the first 25 people to pay costs.

Specifically, the tour of Ghana travels into the following areas:

- I. Addis Ababa (Capital City)
- II. Bahi Dar (Lake Tana, Blue Nile Region)
- III. Gondar (Ancient Castle Region)
- IV. Lalibela (Historic Church Region)

PRICING, PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

The double-occupancy price for each person going to Ethiopia is \$5,800 (subject to changes due to economic situations). This price includes airfare from Washington, DC, lodging, transportation, meals, tours and tips. A single room supplement will require an additional payment of \$1,000+.

- An initial payment of \$1,000 (which includes a non-refundable \$500 administrative processing fee) may be made at any time but must be received by September 1, 2025.
- A second payment of \$1,500 must be made by December 1, 2025.
- A third payment of \$1,500 must be made by March 1, 2026.
- The final payment of \$1,800 must be made by June 1, 2026.
